### Certificate II in Building and Construction Pre-apprenticeship – 22338VIC (Partial Completion)

2022

#### Course Description

The Building Construction course is designed to provide the skills required for a successful career in building construction. Get a taste of the building industry and learn to use a wide variety of building tools and techniques with a partial completion of the pre-apprenticeship program in carpentry. Units in the pre-apprenticeship include safe handling of plant and power tools, quality principles for the building industry, calculations, wall and roof framing, building structures, setting out and workplace documents and plans.

#### Who should apply?

People working in trades are in high demand. This course will provide students interested in the building industry with a sound basis for employment. Careers include Carpenter, Fixing Carpenter, Formwork Carpenter, Joiner, Bricklayer, Builder.

#### Program structure

2 year program

Delivered one afternoon a week with 1 week block delivery during school holidays

#### Special requirements

Safety glasses, protective clothing and safety footwear

#### Pathways

This course has been designed to articulate with Certificate II in General Construction (Carpentry Pre-Apprenticeship) and Traineeship for Construction Worker – General Construction and Carpentry Apprenticeship.



#### VCE subjects

It is recommended that the following units be undertaken:

- English 1 and 2
- Design and Technology 1-4
- General Maths
- Physical Education
- Graphics

#### Work placements

The VCAA strongly recommends a minimum 10 days of work placement for this program.

#### Contribution to the VCE

Upon completion of the VCE VET program, students will have achieved credits towards the pre-apprenticeship certificate. Students wishing to complete the entire pre-apprenticeship certificate will need to undertake modules beyond the requirements of the VCE VET program. The modules in the program have been grouped to form Unit 1-2 and Unit 3-4 sequences for VCE recognition purposes. This course will satisfy learning outcomes for the industry specific skills and work related skills strands in the VCAL program.

#### Benefits

- Completion of both VCE and VET certificates
- Possible exemption from other TAFE courses
- Contribution toward VCE units 1-4
- Opportunity to undertake work placement
- Accredited entry level for other TAFE and university courses
- Pathways to further training
