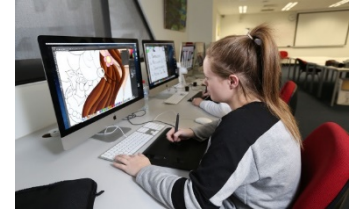

ICT30120 Certificate III in Information, Digital Media and Technology – (Partial Completion)

NEW COURSE IN 2022



Course Description

The Certificate III in IDMT provides students with entry level training in the exciting new medium of digital technology. The course focal point will be the creative side of concept development, Digital painting, video editing, 3D model maker, character design, user interface design, concept art and animation.

Who should apply?

Students who are interested in the creative and technological side of computers and have an open and flexible attitude towards change and advancement in the screen and media industry. With additional training and experience potential employment opportunities may include support games developer, mobile games programmer, and games designer. It will also provide the base knowledge for operating system software, diagnostic testing and working in the ICT environment.

Possible job outcomes

This course will prepare participants for work as web page designers, animators, visualisers and digital video and multimedia producers. With additional training and experience potential employment opportunities can include web designer or developer, games designer, animator or special effects producer.

Program Structure

- 2 year program
- Delivered one afternoon a week
- Holiday block training

VCE subjects

There are no prerequisite subjects, but the following are recommended:

- English 1 and 2 or Industry and Enterprise 1 and 2
- Media 1 and 2
- Information Technology 2 and 3

Work Placements

Work placement is optional in this course; however, if undertaken, it may occur during term holidays, and is highly recommended.

Pathways

This course has been designed to articulate with the Certificate IV in Information, Digital Media and Technology, Diploma of Graphic Design and the Advanced Diploma of Arts (Electronic Design and Interactive Media).

Contribution to the VCE

Students undertaking Certificate III in Information, Digital Media & Technology are eligible for credit of up to four VCE VET units on their VCE Statement of Results. Two of these VCE VET units are at unit 1-2 level and two are at unit 3-4 level.

Students may accumulate VCE VET units over more than one year.

These certificates will satisfy learning outcomes for the industry specific skills and work related skills strands in these VCAL programs.
