

## Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC30121) (partial completion)

### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care prepares students to gain the skills and knowledge to support the wellbeing, learning and development of children from birth to up to 12 years.

### WHO SHOULD APPLY?

This course is ideal for individuals who enjoy working with young children, are nurturing, patient and compassionate, and have good communication skills.

### PRERQUISITE

Students must be in year 11 to commence this program.

### PROGRAM STRUCTURE

2-year program

Delivered one afternoon per week

Students will have the option of completing the full qualification post school.

### WORK PLACEMENTS

Students must complete work placement as detailed in the assessment requirements of the units of competency.

Where student placement is not undertaken, and work placement is required as part of the assessment students will **not be entitled** to their VCE or VCE VM contribution.

### CONTRIBUTION TO THE VCE

Students undertaking this VET DSS program through the VCE stream are eligible for credit of up to four VCE VET units on their VCE Statement of Results: two units at Unit 1-2 level and a Unit 3-4 sequence.

Students may be entitled to 10% increment towards their VCE.

Students undertaking this VET DSS program through the VCE Vocational Major stream will need to complete a minimum of 180 nominal hours of a VET DSS program over a 2-year period.
