Salon Assistant and Retail Cosmetics Dual Qualification

2022

Course Description

The combined course of Hairdressing and Make-up will provide you with a range of basic skills and knowledge in make-up application, retail sales, hair styling and salon services. First and second year are a combination of skills from both specialties within the beauty industry and will provide a solid base for workforce opportunities. At the end of two years you will come out with two Certificate II qualifications. One in Retail Make-up and the other in Salon Assistant. Additional extension workshops will include airbrush, creative and fantasy make-up, along with camouflage and cover-up work.

Who should apply?

Students who are interested in gaining a traineeship or employment within the Hairdressing and Beauty industry. Jobs are expected to increase by 25 per cent in the next five years, so why not consider becoming part of an industry that specialises in the latest looks and trends.

Possible job outcomes

Jobs include Beauty Therapist, Make-up artist, Nail Technician, Hairdresser, Massage Therapist or Salon Manager. Employment can also include stylists for TV, film, theatre, day spas or cruise ships.

Program Structure

Two-year program
Delivered one afternoon a week
Holiday block training

Pathways

Pathways include Certificate III in Beauty Services, Certificate IV in Beauty Therapy, Diploma of Beauty Therapy. You could choose Certificate III in Make-up, Certificate III in Nail Technology or follow the hairdressing stream into Certificate III in Hairdressing or Barbering

Requirements

Students will be required to purchase a Makeup and Hair Tool Kit. Resource and Assessment Folder.

Work placements

It is highly recommended that students undertake a minimum of 10 days work placement. In Warrnambool SWTAFE also has a working salon that provides experience in the workplace.

Contribution to the VCE

The dual qualification can provide a Unit 1-2 sequence for satisfactory completion purposes. Students undertaking these programs are eligible for credit of up to four VCE VET units on their VCE Statement of Results: four units at Unit 1-2 level.

It also provides a contribution towards the VCAL qualification.

Benefits

- Completion of both VCE and VET certificates
- Possible exemptions from other TAFE courses
- Contribution of up to four VCE units and the 1-2.
- Contribution towards VCAL
- Opportunity to undertake work placement
- Accredited entry for other TAFE courses
- Pathways to further training
- Nationally recognised qualification
