VCE SUBJECTS

It is recommended that the following units be undertaken: English units 1 to 4 General Maths units 1 to 4 Health and Humanities units 1 to 4

WORK PLACEMENTS

Students are encouraged to undertake 80 hours of paid or voluntary work within the health/community care industry.

CONTRIBUTION TO THE VCE

Students undertaking Certificate III in Health Services Assistant (partial completion) are eligible for credit of up to four VCE VET units on their VCE Statement of Results: two units at Unit 1-2 level and a Unit 3-4 sequence.

Students have the option to undertake scored assessment, and the study score can be fully counted as one of the student's best four studies for ATAR purposes, or will count as a fifth or sixth study increment, if it is not one of the student's four highest scores.
