Certificate III in Information Technology (ICT30120) (partial completion)

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Certificate III in Information Technology program provides students with entry level training in the exciting new medium of digital technology. This program focal point will be creating ICT user documentation and install, configure a small home office network.

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Students who are interested in the creative and technological side of computers and have an open and flexible attitude towards change and advancement in the information technology industry.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

2 year program

Delivered one afternoon a week

Location: SWTAFE Warrnambool Campus

PATHWAYS

This program will help students prepare for work as web page designers, animators, visualisers and digital video and multimedia producers. With additional training and experience potential employment opportunities can include web designer or developer, games designer, animator or special effects producer.

This program has been designed to articulate with the Certificate IV in Information, Digital Media and Technology, Diploma of Graphic Design and the Advanced Diploma of Arts (Electronic Design and Interactive Media).

VCE SUBJECTS

It is recommended that the following units be undertaken:

- English units 1 to 4
- General Maths units 1 to 4
- Media units 1 to 4

WORK PLACEMENTS

The VCAA strongly recommends a minimum of 80 hours of work placement for this program.

CONTRIBUTION TO THE VCE

Students undertaking Certificate III in Information Technology (partial completion) are eligible for credit of up to four VCE VET units on their VCE Statement of Results: two units at Unit 1-2 level and a Unit 3-4 sequence.

Students have the option to undertake scored assessment, and the study score can be fully counted as one of the student's best four studies for ATAR purposes, or will count as a fifth or sixth study increment, if it is not one of the student's four highest scores.

- Completion of both VCE and VET certificates
- Possible credits from other TAFE courses
- Contribution toward VCE units 1-4
- Opportunity to undertake work placement
- Accredited entry level for other TAFE and university courses
- Pathways to further training
