Course Description

The Certificate III in Tourism is an ideal starting place for a career in the tourism and travel industry. It provides the base knowledge around the travel and tourism industry, explores cultural diversity, visitor information services, accommodation service, social media and volunteering.

Who should apply?

Students should apply who enjoy working with people, love travelling and exploring new destinations. Students will be asked to perform administrative and people orientated tasks.

Possible job outcomes

This course will prepare participants to work in many travel and tourism roles for a diverse range of employers. This may include travel agencies, tour wholesalers, tour operators, visitor information centres, accommodation and other tourism businesses.

Program Structure

- 2 year program
- Delivered one afternoon a week
- Warrnambool and Portland campuses

VCE subjects

There are no prerequisite subjects, but the following are recommended:

- English 1 and 2 or Industry and Enterprise 1 and 2

Work Placements

Students will be required to volunteer for 20 hours as part of a Structured Work Placement.

Pathways

This course is entry level that can lead to Certificate IV in Travel and Tourism, Diploma and Advanced Diploma of Travel and Tourism Management. It also applies relevance to Hospitality and Hotel management industries.

Contribution to the VCE / VCAL

Following the Block Credit rules, VCE students undertaking Certificate III in Tourism (partial completion) will receive a Unit 1, 2, 3, 4, 3 sequence

VCAL Students will receive 1 credit point for every 90 hours completed.
